The Annual "V" Prize Shoot.

The Rules: -

Anyone trying for the prize MUST INFORM THE RCO THAT THEY ARE TRYING FOR TH "V" PRIZE if the RCO is

absent then the Treasurer or Secretary, if present, should be informed. If you do not follow

this rule, then you are not eligible to win.

TARGET: the standard NRA target for the distance.

CALIBRE: .223 minimum.

RIFLES ELIGIBLE: Military rifles in use before 1945 with original iron sights only, may compete from 300yards. Target rifles and any other rifle fitted with iron sights and all telescoped rifles compete from 500 yards.

Supports: Slings or bipods fitted to the rifle are allowed, but no free-standing tripod rests, or any other type of rest. BUTT rests are not allowed. The rifle butt must be clear of the ground when being fired.

The shooting table may be used.

There is no limit to the number of times you may try for the prize, but **each** attempt **must** be notified to the RCO or another qualified person.

If we are using an NRA marker we will have to rely upon their skills. If there is any doubt about the score the RCO/qualified person will make the final decision.
